	Read Mark 10:32-34. Jesus led, the twelve were amazed (literally: excited), and the rest of the crowd was afraid. Why would Mark record the twelve as being excited? Why would the rest of the crowd be afraid?

3.	There are some other similarities between the predictions: Predictions 1 &3 speak of the involvement of the Jewish leadership and predictions 2 & 3 share that He will be handed over. What is different especially concerning the third account?
	ONOR, MISSION, AND GLORY UNDER THE REIGN AND RULE OF GOD Read Mark 10:35-45. Why did Jesus say James and John did not know what they were talking about?
5.	What is the cup Jesus will drink and the Baptism He will be Baptized with? See Isaiah 51:17 and Mark 14:36. What does Jesus promise James and John? See verse 39.
6.	What does Jesus promise James and John? See verse 39.
7.	How is Christian ministry to be different from the way the world conducts its business?
8.	Why did the Son of Man come into the world? What does that mean?

	Read Mark 10:46-52. Note that the healing of a blind man concludes part 3 and part 4 of the Gospel (8:21-26; 10:46-52) and the healing of a deaf man concludes part 2 of the Gospel (7:31-37). What do the blind and deaf have to do with the eschatological reign and rule of God? Read Isaiah 35:4-6.
10.	Look at the blind man's first four words (verse 47). Why is this a great statement of faith?
