

# Advent Meditation on the

**O** Antiphons

December 13, 2023 6:45 pm

#### INTRODUCTION

Advent is a season of the church year when we repent and look toward the coming of Jesus. We remember his coming as a baby in a manger, in His Word and Sacraments, and especially when Jesus comes as Judge and Savior on the Last Day. One of the hymns the Christian Church has sung to express her desire for Christ to come is O Come, O Come Emmanuel. This hymn, written in the 12<sup>th</sup> century, is based on the Great "O Antiphons" of Advent that we sing for tonight.

The "O Antiphons" refer to the seven antiphons that have been recited or chanted before the Magnificat, the song describing Mary's praise to the Lord upon visiting Elizabeth, during the service of evening prayer, called Vespers. In particular, they have been sung from December 17-23, a period known as the Octave before Christmas.

These antiphons express longing for the coming of Christ Jesus using seven different titles extracted from the book of Isaiah, such as O Wisdom, O Lord, and O Emmanuel. These titles are followed by prayers asking for Jesus to come and fulfill an Old Testament promise or prophecy. In this way, the O Antiphons have served as short prayers which paraphrase Scripture and have been cherished for centuries by Christian worshippers as a great, expressive desire for the coming of the Savior.

Tonight, as we anticipate the same joy for Christ and his coming, let us pray the O Antiphons, meditate on them, and sing them.

#### OPENING HYMN

#### **ANTIPHON**

<sup>21</sup>For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know him, God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe. <sup>22</sup>Jews demand miraculous signs and Greeks look for wisdom, <sup>23</sup>but we preach Christ crucified: a stumbling-block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles, <sup>24</sup>but to those whom God has called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. <sup>25</sup>For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

<sup>30</sup>It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God – that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.



And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you."

# O Radix Jesse (O Root of Jesse)


December 19

#### **ANTIPHON**

- P & Root of Jesse, standing as an ensign before the peoples, before whom all kings are mute, to whom the nations will do homage:
- Come quickly to deliver us.

<sup>26</sup> In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, <sup>27</sup> to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. And the virgin's name was Mary. <sup>28</sup> And he came to her and said, "Greetings, O favored one, the Lord is with you!" <sup>29</sup> But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and tried to discern what sort of greeting this might be. <sup>30</sup> And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. <sup>31</sup> And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. <sup>32</sup> He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. 


# O Clavis David (O Key of David)

#### **ANTIPHON**

- P & Key of David and scepter of the house of Israel, You open and no one can close, You close and no one can open:
- Come and rescue the prisoners who are in darkness and the shadow of death.



#### **READINGS**

#### Isaiah 22:22

<sup>22</sup>I will place on his shoulder the key to the house of David; what he opens no one can shut, and what he shuts no one can open.

#### Matthew 16:13-19

<sup>13</sup> Now when Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" <sup>14</sup> And they said, "Some say John the Baptist, others say Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets." <sup>15</sup> He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" <sup>16</sup> Simon Peter replied, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." <sup>17</sup> And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. <sup>18</sup> And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. <sup>19</sup> I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

#### **ANTIPHON**

- O come and save us all, whom You formed out of clay.

#### READINGS

#### Isaiah 9:6-7

<sup>6</sup>For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. <sup>7</sup>Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.


#### Jeremiah 10:6-10

# O Emmanuel (O God-With-Us)


