Instructions for Communing

We use <u>continuous kneeling tables</u> for Holy Communion. The congregation will be ushered forward to kneel. You will receive the Body of Jesus from the Pastors and then the Blood of Jesus from the Elder/Vicar. You may receive either from the common cup or the individual cup. When you have sufficiently meditated, stand, reverence the altar, and return to your seat. Those not communing will receive a blessing from the pastor.

Non-alcoholic white wine in located in the center of each tray and should only be used by those with medical conditions prohibiting the use of wine.

Gluten-free wafers are available from the pastor when you come forward.

Voice of the Martyrs prayer request Pastors Train Children with Illegal Gospel - Central Asia

Pastors in Central Asia are faithfully teaching the gospel to children even though such action is against the law. In many post-Soviet countries, teaching religion to children under age 18 is illegal. As followers of Christ, however, these pastors know it is important for young people to learn about the Bible and faith in God from a young age. Some of the pastors hold summer camps for children, and these camps attract both Christians and non-Christian participants. In fact, some of the children come from Muslim families who appreciate the lessons and activities that their children experience. Pray for these leaders as they teach the children at great personal risk, and pray that the children learn much about God.
