Dear Friends in Christ,

The Board of Elders and pastors have spent much time trying to navigate the ever changing issues surrounding COVID-19. It is our earnest desire, as we have any in-person worship, education, or fellowship events, to keep our members healthy, to minimize risk to our members, and to continue to be able to meet in person for these various in-person events.

Due to **health department mandates for our preschool** and the continuation of the **Governor’s Executive order (20-52)** requiring face-masks and other coverings while in public regardless of social distancing, the Board of Elders (with support from the pastors) voted on and approved the **requirement that face masks or other face coverings must be worn during any event inside BSLC.**

Additionally, please note that due to health department regulations and daily cleaning schedules, the preschool classrooms and nursery/MDO room are off limits to all church functions/uses.

There are a few exceptions to the mask requirement:

- Pastors and Vicar are not required to wear a mask while teaching as long as they maintain a minimum of 6-foot distance from participants. (Masks will be worn by Pastors and Vicar while not teaching);
- Persons age five years and under should not wear a face covering because of the risk of suffocation;
- Persons with a medical condition, mental health condition, or disability that prevents wearing a face covering--this includes persons with a medical condition for whom wearing a face-covering could obstruct breathing;
- Persons who are deaf or hard of hearing or communicating with a person who is deaf or hard of hearing, where the ability to see the mouth is essential for communication.
