In the Old Testament, God commanded people to tithe (give one-tenth). The tithe determined the portion and amount that people were to give. The tithe was given to support the temple and the ministry of the Levites. In the New Testament, proportional giving is also commanded. *"On the first of every week, each of you is to put something aside and store it up, as he may prosper, so that there will be no collecting when I come"* (1 Corinthians 16:2). The New Testament does not specify any specific dollar amount that we are to give, but we are to give generously from the blessings that God entrusts to us. The more we prosper, the more we are to give.
