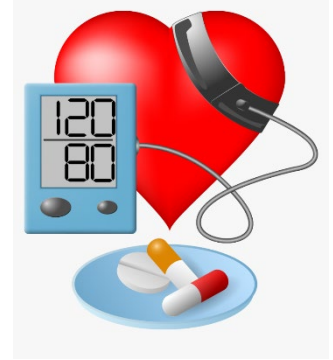

HYGIENE KITS for ORPHAN GRAIN TRAIN

Orphan Grain Train has been helping provide humanitarian aid donations for the Ukrainian refugees. Our hygiene kits will help replenish their supplies. The **TOWEL TOWER** has been set up in the narthex. We are collecting **lightweight, dark-colored, regular-sized bath towels (no oversized) and washcloths**. Other items to be added are single-packaged **toothbrushes, nail clippers, and bath-size bars of soap**.

Our goal was 50 kits but we will assemble as many kits as possible with incoming donations. We have 16 towels and washcloths so far. We will be collecting through April.

SPRINGTIME AND HOLY WEEK

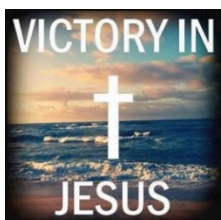
