
**KANSAS FAMILY VOICE**

### HYGIENE KITS for ORPHAN GRAIN TRAIN

Orphan Grain Train has been helping provide humanitarian aid donations for the Ukrainian refugees. Our hygiene kits will help replenish their supplies. The **TOWEL TOWER** has been set up in the narthex. We are collecting **light-weight, dark-colored, regular-sized bath towels (no oversized) and washcloths**. Other items to be added are: single-packaged **toothbrushes, nail clippers, and bath-size bars of soap**.

Our goal was 50 kits but we will assemble as many kits as possible with incoming donations. **We have 28 towels and washcloths, 24 soap, and 8 nail clippers so far. We will be collecting through April.**


**HOLY WEEK AND EASTER**
