HYGIENE KITS for ORPHAN GRAIN TRAIN

Orphan Grain Train has been helping provide humanitarian aid donations for the Ukrainian

refugees. Our hygiene kits will help replenish their supplies. The **TOWEL TOWER** has been set up in the narthex. We are collecting **light-weight**, **dark-colored**, **regular-sized bath towels** (no oversized) and washcloths. Other items to be added are: single-packaged toothbrushes, nail clippers, and bath-size bars of soap.

Our goal was 50 kits but we will assemble as many kits as possible with incoming donations. We have 28 towels and washcloths, 24 soap, and 8 nail clippers so far. We will be collecting through April.
