At the LWML Kansas District convention, voters selected the mission grants and committed to fund \$43,000 in mission grants and \$40,000 in Student Financial Aid in the next two years. \$5200 from a Mission Grant Endowment Fund will provide additional support! God's Gracious Gift Fund recipients were also

chosen. \$22,034 for those will be paid out in the next few weeks.

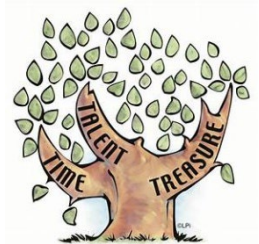
SPRING PROGRAM
