## PRESCHOOL

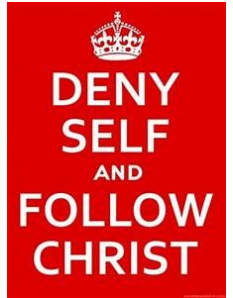
