
We also have retired Pastors worshiping with us as members. We thank them for their work in His church and continue to keep them in our prayers!

This process of becoming a Spirit-led steward is called sanctification. Sanctification is the work of the Spirit. The Spirit calls, gathers, enlightens, sanctifies, and keeps us in the true faith. This includes stewardship. The Holy Spirit does this by the Gospel. Stewardship that does not begin and end in the Gospel is not faithful stewardship.
