SCHOOL HAS STARTED! For many years, our congregation has supported the students at Pioneer Trail Middle School who participate in the Backsnack program. The program provides food items that supplement weekend meals for those students who are signed up. (According to publicschoolreview.com, 46% of the 691 students are on the free or reduced lunch assistance.) The extra food that is provided for that student on the weekends is very much appreciated by those families who may be struggling financially. There are approximately 35 students signed up so far but that number will most likely increase. We have been asked to continue providing a portion of the items included in the backpacks for the school year.
