One Night, Samuel runs to Eli, thinking Eli is calling his name. Eli sends Samuel back to bed, assuring him he had not called. As the pattern repeats, Eli tells Samuel to lie down once again but the next time respond, "Speak Lord, Your servant hears" (1 Samuel 3:9).
