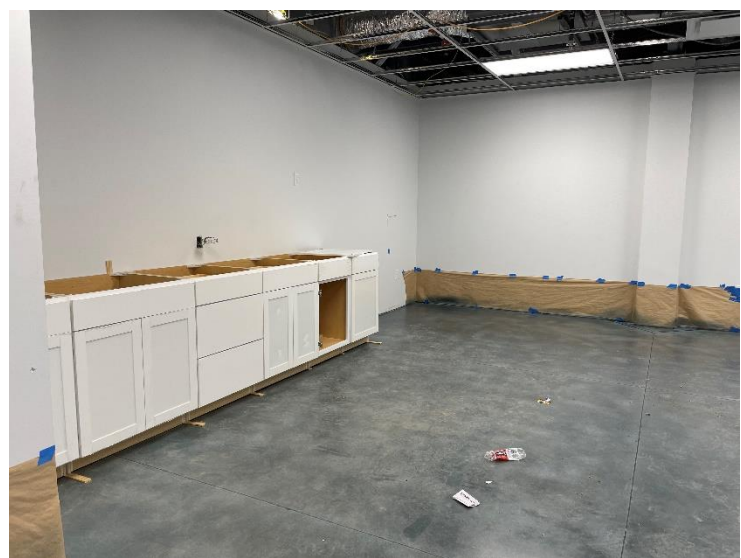

PIONEER TRAIL BACKSNACK PROGRAM UPDATE:

Beautiful Savior is continuing to support the 45 students who are signed up for the program this 2021-22 school year. Our contributions are some of the items that are given to the students to help provide nutritional food for over the weekend. Each month we need to provide these food items for each of the 45 students:

2 boxes of cereal (size that will fit in backpack)

1 box of Breakfast Bars (any size box with at least a 4 count any type of granola bars, protein bars, etc.)

1 4-pack fruit cups (any larger count is fine)

CHRISTMAS FOOD BASKETS We have started our collection of items for the 120 Christmas Food Baskets that Jesus El Buen Pastor Lutheran Church Food Pantry, in Kansas City, Mo., provides to families at Christmas. These baskets provide a more joyous celebration for families-in-need. We are providing a **4 lb. bag of sugar, 5 lb. bag of flour** and a **48 oz. bottle of vegetable oil** to be included in each of the 120 baskets. At this time, we still need 94 bags of sugar, 90 bags of flour and 94 bottles of oil. The **deadline** for collecting these is **Wed., Dec. 8**.
