BUILDING UPDATE

Recap of Phase 1 Construction

Work Progress

- 2nd Floor Steel, Roofing and Liner Panels are delivered and stored on site.
- 1st Floor Steel is fabricated and stored at the fabricator for delivery when required.
- Fellowship and Maintenance Building pads are graded and leveled.
- Opening for the connecting hallway is being prepared.
- Concrete footings for the Fellowship Building are in process.
- Access Road and Laydown yard created and are being put to use.
- Water main extension around new construction is completed. Only tie-in remains.
- All utilities have been relocated. Only tie-in remains.
- Earthwork mass grading for Detention Structure, Fellowship Building, and Maintenance Building are nearing rough grade completion.
- The new parking lot rough grade, Storm Water Structures and Piping to Detention Structure and sub-grading remain to be executed.
- Duct work has been delivered and stored on site.
- New sanctuary fire escape has been installed.

Financial Info

Costs are on track per Opinion of Probable Cost (OPC) previously shared and approved. OPC = \$5.65M

Construction costs paid through 3/31/2021 = \$861k

Contracts have been executed totaling \$4.3M

Contracts executed: irrigation, masonry, EIFS, interior walls, drywall, steel erection, retaining wall, elevator, fire sprinkler, fire alarm, maintenance building, erosion control, surveying/staking, earthmoving/excavation, concrete, steel, plumbing, mechanical, electrical

Contracts remaining to be executed are estimated to be \$600k

Additional costs beyond contracts are estimated to be approximately \$850k.

These costs include: general requirements, contingencies, and Laborers For Christ (LFC) administrative or labor costs.

Trusting Hearts has received \$1.328M (68% of goal)

BACKSNACK PROGRAM Thank you for all the donations for the Pioneer Trail backsnack program. The school year is almost over. Pioneer Trail has informed us that they have enough soup for this school year. (If you have already bought more soup, bring it and we will donate it to a local food pantry.) Please continue donating CEREAL and FRUIT CUPS through mid-May. Thanks again.

SACK LUNCHES the time has been extended thru the end of May. We will be collecting food items to be included in sack lunches that Metro Lutheran Ministries will distribute to those in need. Last year the number of lunches they gave out each day had drastically increased – 6000 in a two-month period. The need is still there. Our goal is 300 lunches. The lunches will be assembled as one of the mission projects planned for the children participating in VBS in June.

We will focus on providing the protein items that the people prefer. The single serve boxed tuna salad kits and the chicken salad kits are well liked; as well as turkey and beef sticks. They also enjoy the fruit cups instead of applesauce cups.

- Tuna salad kits (Snack size – approx.. 3 oz.)
- Chicken salad kits (Snack size – approx.. 3 oz.)
- Turkey and Beef sticks (indivi. wrapped)
- Fruit cups (not applesauce)

Our goal for the MLM sack lunches is 300. Here are the counts so far:

Tuna/Chicken salad kits (approx. 3 oz preferred): 58

Fruit cups (No applesauce): 44

Beef/Turkey sticks: 42
