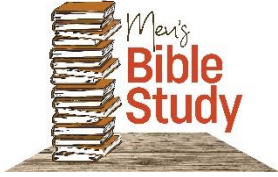

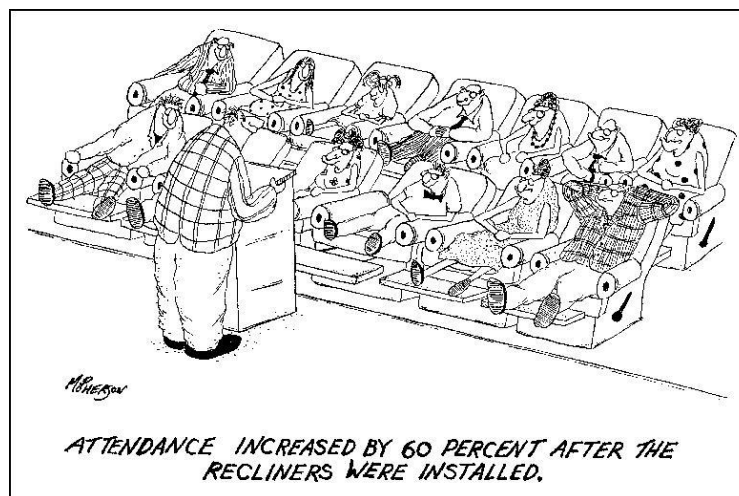
their moms with our group. The Zoom meeting ended with a slideshow of all of our Pre-K graduates.
