
Celebration of Life for Bill Rinne Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church Tuesday, May 18, 2021, 2:00 pm

#### STEWARDSHIP CORNER

At the same time, the Spirit of God is working in us, the world, the flesh, and the devil – our old enemies – battle against Him for control of our souls. In Romans 6:17-18, the Apostle Paul wrote, "But thanks be to God that, though you used to be slaves to sin, you wholeheartedly obeyed the form of teaching to which you were entrusted. You have been set free from sin and have become slaves to righteousness." Although we are participants in this battle against our sinful natures, we are also victors through Christ Who has already won the battle and rescued us from death. No longer are we powerless over sin. "Sin shall not be [our] master, because [we] are not under law, but under grace" (Romans 6:14). As God, the holy Judge, looks at us, clothed now in Jesus' white robe of righteousness, He no longer sees sinful creatures, but pure and blameless new creations.
