EVANGELIZING AND THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

An Open Doors ministry 2019 report states that "In the top 50 World Watch List (WWL) countries alone, 245 million Christians in the world experience high levels of persecution for their choice to follow Christ." It was also reported that in these countries, "105 churches are attacked, burned or vandalized each month." A seven-week presentation on the persecuted church will begin Thursday, May 23rd, (please note the date change) 6:15-7:30 pm at Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church. The time you spend at the event will show a side of evangelism that most in this country do not know. You will learn about those who have dedicated everything to Christ Jesus. They joyously, and sometimes fearfully, evangelize to those who persecute them. Often their joy is difficult to understand but it is very real. The first week you will see the Voice of the Martyrs (VOM) movie, "Tortured for Christ." This movie is

based upon a portion of the true-life story of a Lutheran Pastor, Richard Wurmbrand. Pastor Wurmbrand was a part of the underground church in Communist Romania. He served a total of 14 years in prison where he was beaten and tortured for his faith. After being ransomed for \$10,000, the Pastor, his wife and son were then convinced by his congregation to leave Romania and tell the world about the persecuted church. The six weeks following the movie will focus on the "Persecuted Church." Like the first week, we begin at 6:15 and end at 7:30. Each session will begin with a 15-minute video that will lead to a time for more information, discussion, and questions. Each session will take us a bit deeper into the work the persecuted church does as it shares the good news of Jesus Christ. I do hope you can attend. If you cannot, please pray for God's blessings on this effort. The work being done is evangelism and we pray that this effort will increase focus on our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
