Dear Brothers & Sisters.

According to our Constitution and Bylaws, we were to have a regularly scheduled voters' meeting in April for the election of officers and board members and for any other topic needing congregation approval. Due to COVID-19 and the subsequent state-wide ban on gatherings over 10 people, I had delayed having the meeting in hopes we could meet as a congregation. It is now clear to me it will be into July or later before we can do this, so I ask for your understanding in the postponement of our regular meeting to the end of May. Council has scheduled our next voters' meeting for Sunday, May 31st at 11:30AM. We will have the meeting in the parking lot after our 10:30AM communion service and, much like our communion service, our meeting will be adapted to allow for social distancing. We will broadcast the meeting over our radio station so you can hear it from your car. Should you have questions, you may text them to me during the meeting. Additionally, we will have a microphone set up should someone wish to ask a question or speak to the congregation directly. My request for use of the microphone is the usual protocol of stating your name and limiting your time to two minutes with the additional request that you wear a mask and do not touch the microphone. Voting will be done via ballots which will be distributed by the Elders upon your arrival and will be collected by the Elders when votes are cast. Please be patient as we conduct our meeting in this manner. As I stated previously, the purpose of the regular April meeting is for the election of officers and board members and for any other topics needing voter approval. Click here for the final slate of officers and board members for your review prior to the voters' meeting.

The other item for which Council will request voter approval regards the building project. For the past several months, the BSLC Building Committee has been working diligently with Laborers for Christ (LFC) on subcontracts and pricing and with Lutheran Church Extension Fund (LCEF) on the construction loan. In order to close the loan, LCEF requires an Opinion of Probable Cost (OPC) to determine worst-case total cost of construction. This is all done to ensure adequate funding is available for the building to be completed and usable. Other information was sent to you in an email from Doug Mahnken on Monday. Council will be asking for congregation approval to proceed with the project and authorization for execution of a construction loan in the amount of \$4.2 million. More information will follow regarding costs, loan terms and other details needed for an informed decision.

Thank you for your understanding, consideration and, most importantly, prayers. May God continue to guide us in this endeavor.
