VIRTUAL VBS 2020 AT BEAUTIFUL SAVIOR STARTS ON JUNE 1ST!!

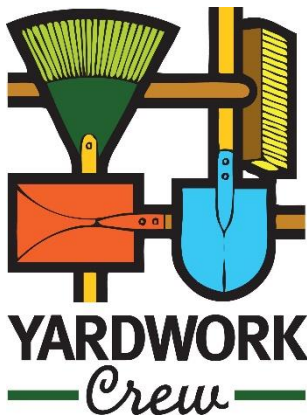

CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

The Board of Trustees is seeking volunteers to assist with grounds maintenance at Beautiful Savior. Our biggest need is for mowers (preferably teams of 2-3) and individuals to weed our landscaping beds.

Mowing solo is about a 5-6 hour job every week (pre-construction) with trimming needed every two weeks. We have two riding Skag lawnmowers so a team of two should be able to complete the mowing job in less than 3 hours. Gas powered trimmers are also available to complete the trimming work.
