Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am writing to inform you of two **CONGREGATION FORUMS** we will be holding this week **concerning expansion of our facilities**. The first forum will be held during the **Sunday morning educational hour on June 16th** and the other will be at **7:00PM on Tuesday, June 18th**. While there will be no motions or votes at these forums, the intent is to provide information sufficient to allow for action by voters at a **Special Voters' Meeting to be held at 12:15PM on Sunday, July 7th**.

At these forums we will cover how we got here over the last two years including review of the Long Range Planning Committee's work, the Building Committee's work and the **most recent floor plans which are provided via an email link** that was included in an email sent Tuesday morning. PLEASE look at these plans carefully, in order to be informed. Additionally, we will discuss possible future building funding through Lutheran Church Extension Fund (LCEF) and building construction by LCEF Laborers for Christ.

During the first forum on June 16th, questions will be limited due to the time constraint of the education hour. However, at the June 18th meeting we will have more time to address any and all questions. If your schedule permits, I would encourage you to attend both forums – the first to receive the information and process it for questions during the second.

Finally, please prayerfully consider the needs of our ministry and the required physical spaces. At the Special Voters' Meeting on July 7th, Council will be asking the congregation to take action and approve a capital campaign to bring all the planning and work to fruition.
