### **VOTERS' MEETING UPDATE**

On May 31<sup>st</sup>, BSLC held our semiannual voters' meeting in the church parking lot. Agenda items included the 2020-2021 slate of officers and board members as well as our building expansion project. The slate was approved and new officers and board members will be installed into their respective roles in a future church service. Regarding the building expansion project, after receiving construction bids and compiling a worst-case cost scenario as required by LCEF, the overall project cost was higher than what was approved by voters in July 2019. BSLC Council sought voter approval to proceed with the project as planned despite the higher cost. BSLC voters' approved the cost and the plan to proceed with the project.

### **RAINFOREST EXPLORERS VIRTUAL VBS**

104 of our youngest brothers and sisters in Christ joined us for 4 days of learning about Jesus and His love for each of them. 

## CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS

The Board of Trustees is seeking volunteers to assist with grounds maintenance at Beautiful Savior. Our biggest need is for mowers (preferably teams of 2-3) and individuals to weed our landscaping beds.
