Dear Friends in Christ,

After three weeks of being back in church for Sunday services, my thoughts are on the words of the Psalmist: **“I was glad when they said to me, ‘Let us go into the house of the LORD’” (Psalm 122:1).** What a joy it has been to have about 150 of our members back at Beautiful Savior for in person worship! If you are not ready to be back for live worship, I completely understand and rejoice that you join us each Sunday at 8:00am via our YouTube channel.

Due to several factors the Elders and Pastors have decided to make a few **changes to our Sunday morning schedule** in order to make worship as safe and accessible as possible for our family of faith.

1. **8:00am – (NO CHANGE)** – Live worship with Holy Communion AND On-line worship via YouTube. We **WILL continue the alphabet split** for worship at this service. **SO, this Sunday, July 12 is last names A-L.**
2. **9:00am – (NOTE THE TIME CHANGE)** – Live and Streamed Adult BC, Youth BC, and Sunday School. **Anyone is welcome in person.**
3. **10:15am – (NOTE THE TIME CHANGE)** – Parking lot communion service. If you have **friends from other congregations** who have been coming to this service, please let them know about the time change.
4. **11:00am – (NOTE THE TIME CHANGE)** – Live worship with Holy Communion. We **WILL NOT continue the alphabet split** for this service.

SO, if you would like to come to a live worship service every week, we ask that you would either **(A)** attend the 11:00am service every week OR **(B)** attend the 8:00am service that corresponds to your name and attend the 11:00 am service on the alternate weeks.

I rejoice that those who have attended a live service have been filled with care and compassion for others and have gladly worn masks in and out of BSLC and when you have been unable to be socially distant. You may also remove your mask for the worship service as long as you sing softly. Additionally, please remember to stay home if you are sick and wash/sanitize your hands regularly.

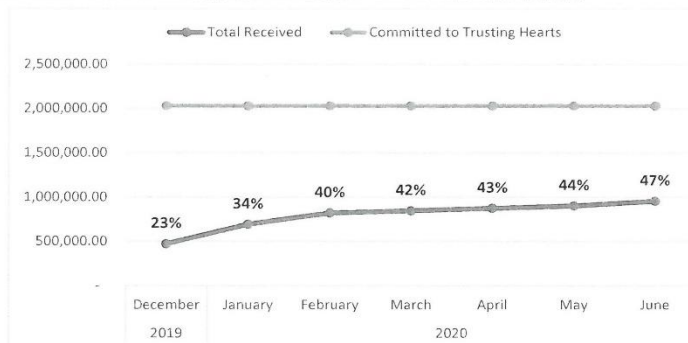

LWML FOCUSES ON MISSIONS When the Kansas District LWML delegates voted in June,

they chose to set the mite goal for the next two years at \$145,000. This includes \$43,000 for the selected mission grants, \$40,000 for Student Financial Aid for church work students attending one of the Concordia Universities, over \$36,000 for national LWML work and mission grants (this is 25% of the overall mite goal) and the rest for operating, convention, publication, and leadership training expenses. They were also able to disburse over \$13,000 for mission recipients from the God's Gracious Gift Fun. To God be the glory!
