- 8:00am (NO CHANGE) Live worship with Holy Communion AND On-line worship via YouTube. We <u>WILL continue the alphabet split</u> for worship at this service. SO, this Sunday, July 19 is last names M-Z.
- 9:00am (NOTE THE TIME CHANGE) Live and Streamed Adult BC, Youth BC, and Sunday School. <u>Anyone is welcome in person.</u>
- 3. 10:15am (NOTE THE TIME CHANGE) Parking lot communion service. If you have <u>friends from other congregations</u> who have been coming to this service, please let them know about the time change.
- 4. **11:00am (NOTE THE TIME CHANGE) –** Live worship with Holy Communion. We **WILL NOT continue the alphabet split** for this service.

SO, if you would like to come to a live worship service every week, we ask that you would either **(A)** attend the 11:00am service every week OR **(B)** attend the 8:00am service that corresponds to your name and attend the 11:00 am service on the alternate weeks.

I rejoice that those who have attended a live service have been filled with care and compassion for others and have gladly worn masks in and out of BSLC and when you have been unable to be socially distant. You may also remove your mask for the worship service as long as you sing softly. Additionally, please remember to stay home if you are sick and wash/sanitize your hands regularly.
