

STEWARDSHIP CORNER

God sets no boundaries on His giving to us. In the words of Martin Luther, “He richly and daily provides me with all that I need to support this body and life.” (Martin Luther’s Small Catechism). In response to God’s great love for us and His bountiful gifts to us, we are enabled by grace to share with others the wealth He has given us. God uses us as conduits of His love and His goodness so that no one has to be in need. Paul said that “[our] abundance at the present time should supply their need, so that their abundance may supply your need, that there may be fairness” (2 Corinthians 8:14). In this way, God is honored, our need to give is satisfied, and those in need are provided for.
