This fundraiser is a significant way that LWML supports our own church member to spread the Gospel of Christ.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, some things will be different this year, but the products from Farmstead will be the same high quality and just as tasty as in past years. There will be a few cash and carry items offered this year. Through a Thrivent Action Team, favorite Farmstead Nuts & Treats items will be offered for sale in the narthex on Sunday, September 20 and 27. Order forms will be sent to the congregation via email so watch for a pdf link that can be printed in your own home. Print as many as you need to share with a friend or neighbor. Alternatively, there will be some order forms available in the narthex (look for the fall fundraiser table). Order forms will not be placed in every church mailbox this year.

Because we are helping support seven students, a new promotion to offer free delivery has been created. If your order or order plus donation totals over \$75, you will be given the option of free delivery by an LWML volunteer!

Fundraiser orders will be collected through October 4 with delivery in mid-October.


