Stewardship Corner

Many Christians have misconceptions misunderstandings and have been misdirected about what stewardship is, so they often react negatively when it's talked or written about. One of the major misconceptions is that we associate stewardship only with encouraging us to give more money in support of the church. When we spend time to understand the true purpose and meaning of stewardship, we will disconnect stewardship from the idea that it is only about "paying the bills." At the heart of stewardship is a personal, intimate relationship with Jesus. The goal of the stewardship ministry in our church is to help us grow in our relationship with Jesus through the use of the time, talents, and treasures that God has entrusted to us.
