### SUNDAY SCHOOL

This week's lesson is "Lost-and-Found Wonders." Jesus shares three parables demonstrating our heavenly Father's concern for the lost. The shepherd leaves the ninety-nine sheep to seek one that was

lost. A woman sweeps the house to find one of ten silver coins. In the parable of the lost son, a young man squanders his inheritance, ending up in squalor. Determined to plead for his father's mercy and beg to return as a servant, the son instead receives a celebration. Angered at his father's welcome for the prodigal, the older son confronts his father. The father's gentle response reassures the young man of the father's everlasting love and care.

#### RESCHEDULED DATE - INVITE TO SAFETY TRAINING MEETING 2026

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,  
You are invited to attend one of the upcoming safety training sessions at BSLC. The goal is for you to have information and training to respond to an emergency at BSLC until EMS can arrive. You are the bridge to best outcomes for our members and visitors. If you are present at church on a regular basis this class is for you! (That should be all members☺)

The sessions are expected to be 45min to an hour depending on questions and discussions. This is not a class to obtain certification in CPR or 1<sup>st</sup> Aid, but rather a refresher and information on location and use of supportive measures at BSLC.

Planned topics to cover include:

1. Location and use of AED's in our church, with brief CPR / Choking overview

2. Location and use of Naloxone (Narcan) for drug overdose
3. Location and use of "stop the bleed" kits
4. Location of First Aid supplies/ what supplies are included and available/ wheelchair and blankets
5. Fire safety and evacuation procedures
6. Location of tornado shelters and tornado kits/ building exits
7. Management of events/ communication (ie making sure 911 is called, crowd control, identifying victim/family)
