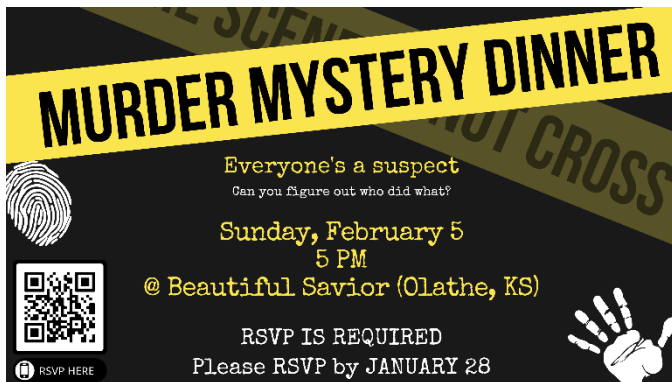

THIS WEEK IN SUNDAY SCHOOL

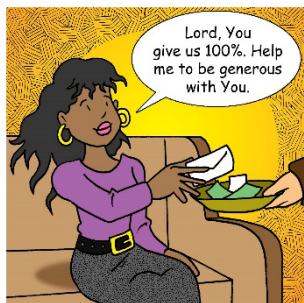

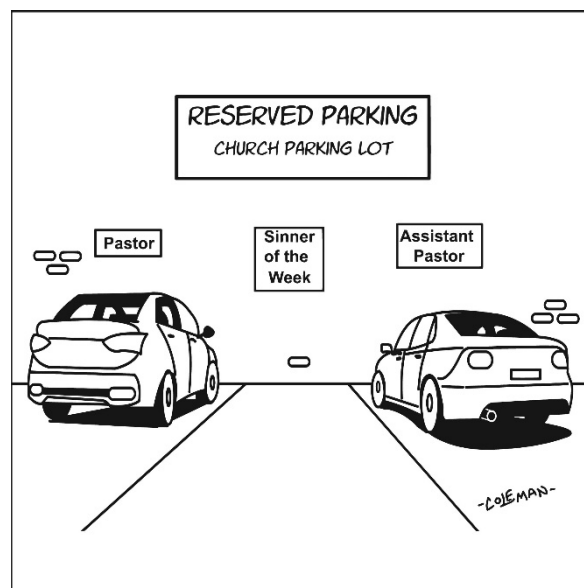
