FEBRUARY NEWSLETTER ARTICLE

The Board of Member Engagement and Assimilation is responsible for welcoming visitors to our worship services. We started with hosting monthly visitor coffees since August, but we now want to welcome visitors every week. To do so, we are planning to have a Visitor Host at each worship service. The Host will stand with our Greeters near the entry doors and focus on welcoming any visitors. The Host will then help visitors with the following:

- Offer them a nametag at the visitor desk so our members can identify and welcome them before and after the service.
- Encourage them to provide their contact information on the visitor attendance form or online attendance so BMEA can follow up.
- Offer them a visitor flyer which includes information on our beliefs, Sunday morning schedule, upcoming events, and pastor contact information.
- Introduce them to pastors (if available) and hopefully a member or two in the narthex if time permits.
- Help them find seats in the sanctuary for worship.
- After early service, invite them to join us for coffee and donuts in the Fellowship Hall and stay for Education Hour. Offer to show them where children's classes meet if applicable. Introduce them to members as you have opportunities.
- After late service, thank them for worshipping with us and ask if they have any questions. Invite them to join us again the following week.

Doing these things will be especially helpful for first-time visitors, but will also benefit repeat visitors. Hosts can be individuals or couples. Please contact Bruce Kempin at phone number: 316-841-6123 or email: sbkem7@gmail.com if you are interested in serving as a Host. We plan to have Hosts at each service beginning March 1st.

Romans 15:7 tells us to "Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God." We encourage all members to look for visitors on Sunday morning and take a moment to introduce yourself and welcome them. Please also wear your name tag so our visitors can begin to make connections quickly. May the Holy Spirit move us to joyfully welcome our visitors for the glory of God!

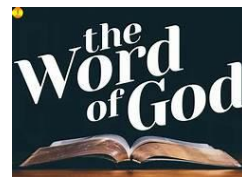
STEWARDSHIP
