FLEECE FABRIC FOR BLANKETS

In February, Missions will be collecting fleece fabric to make warm blankets. We will advertise later when the blankets will be assembled (tying) so you may join us if you'd like. It's a very easy process. The blankets will be donated to Orphan Grain Train for distribution to the needy.

- **Each blanket uses a 2-yard length of fleece fabric for the top AND a 2-yard length of fleece fabric for the bottom.**

- The fabric can be any color. Blankets made in the past have used a fleece design piece for the top with a coordinating solid fleece piece for the bottom.

(FYI -These blankets are bigger than the blanket "kits" sold in fabric stores.)



- If you only want to donate a 2-yard piece of fleece, that is fine. We can coordinate it with other donated pieces. We hope to be able to donate several warm blankets.

We're excited to introduce our rebranding from Advice & Aid Pregnancy Centers to Two Lines Pregnancy Clinic—a name that reflects the defining moment when a woman sees two lines on a pregnancy test.

Our mission remains the same. We exist to encourage women and families facing an unplanned pregnancy to choose life by serving them before, during and after with Christ-like compassion. With this rebrand, our goal is to reach 1,500 women annually. We want to reach them at the moment they are filled with uncertainty, fear, and questions about what's next. But at Two Lines, we see those lines differently—as a symbol of hope, possibility, and life.

Messy. Scary. Impossible. That's where we meet mothers, in the chaos of unplanned pregnancies. When everything feels overwhelming and nothing aligns with their plans, we're here—offering clarity, support, and compassionate care.

The other two lines in our name also represent two heartbeats—a profound reminder of the connection between mother and baby. These lines reflect our focus to stand by women with empathy and love, assuring them that they are never alone.

Our services remain steadfast: pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, health assessments, post-pregnancy support, abortion pill reversal, post-abortive support, and access to an extensive network of community resources that extend far beyond our clinic.

At Two Lines, we provide the information every woman deserves, the healthcare every woman deserves to find, and the love every woman needs to feel. This is more than a name change—it's a renewed commitment to every woman's journey from uncertainty to hope.



From Unexpected to Expectant: We're there every step of the way.

Two lines bring **chaos**.
