HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #12

Completed Week of January 13th:

- The fire/security contractor completed installation and testing of duct smoke detectors.
- The HVAC contractor completed the main ductwork for the FH. Branch connection and diffusers installed in the north closet.
- The structural contractor completed sheetrock taping and mudding sheetrock. Walls ready for painting. Ceiling grid installed

in East stairwell, north closet, and old mechanical / HVAC control room.

- JR and company on site to measure for the metal sound wall coping.

Completed Week of January 20th:

- The HVAC contractor completed all ductwork and completed the mechanical installation and relocation of the HVAC units. The contractor demobilized from the work site. The contractor will return to site for balancing, final control commissioning, and training.
- The structural contractor finished re-installing ceiling grid work and installed outer ceiling panels in the two (2) west upper level closets, the west stairwell, and in the electrical panel room in the lower level. The contractor completed installation of the door frame for the Youth Room new closet.
- The electrical contractor started re-installing lights in the west upper-level closets and the west stairwell. The contractor completed reinstalling lights in the lower-level electrical panel room.
- The fire/security contractor finished re-installing all audio/visual strobes and performed a function test for the alarm system.
- The painting contractor finished all the required painting.
- The fire suppression contractor completed lowering of 4 sprinkler heads due to the ceiling being lowered to accommodate the new ductwork in the south upper-level closet.

Work Scheduled for week of January 27th:

- Above ceiling inspection by the City of Olathe scheduled for Wednesday, January 29th.
- Electrical contractor to finish re-installing lights and trimming out the alcove closet.

- The concrete contractors return to site to form and pour the sidewalk and patio due to favorable weather to finish the concrete part of the project..
- The sheet metal contractor scheduled to install the metal coping on the top of the sound enclosure wall.
- The structural contractor scheduled to install the sound enclosure man door.

We are trying to have interior work 100% completed by the second week in February.

FLEECE FABRIC FOR BLANKETS

In February, we will continue to collect fleece fabric to make warm blankets. Your first opportunity to help assemble (tying) the blankets will be at the BSLC Women's Retreat on Saturday, Feb. 22. It's a very easy process. The blankets will be donated to Orphan Grain Train for distribution to the needy.



- Each blanket uses a **2-yard length** of fleece fabric for the **top** AND a **2-yard length** of fleece fabric for the **bottom**.
- The fabric can be any color. Blankets made in the past have used a fleece design piece for the top with a coordinating solid fleece piece for the bottom.
(FYI -These blankets are bigger than the blanket "kits" sold in fabric stores.)
- If you only want to donate a 2-yard piece of fleece, that is fine. We can coordinate it with other donated pieces. We hope to be able to donate several warm blankets.

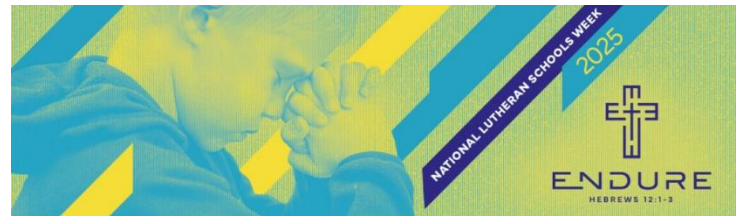

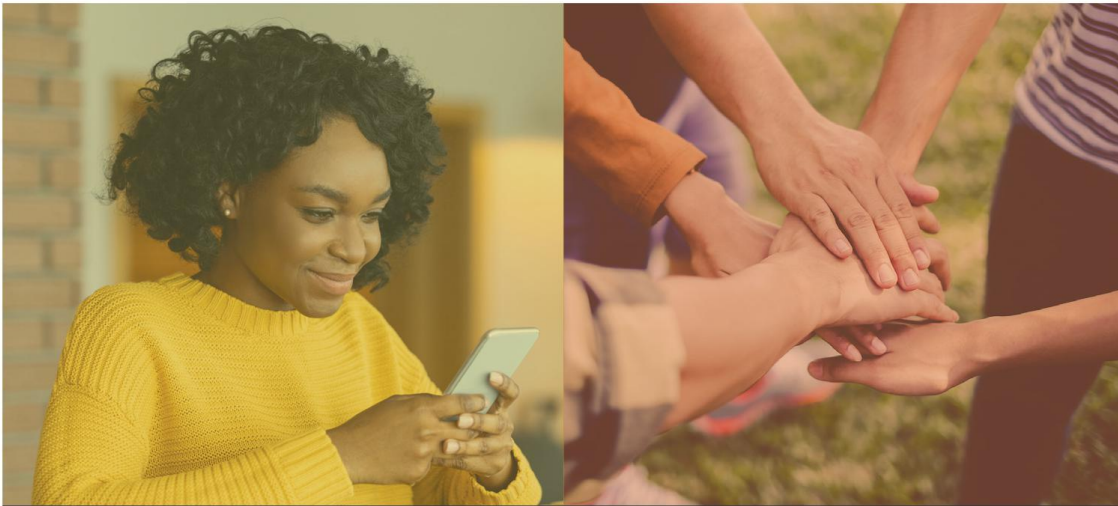

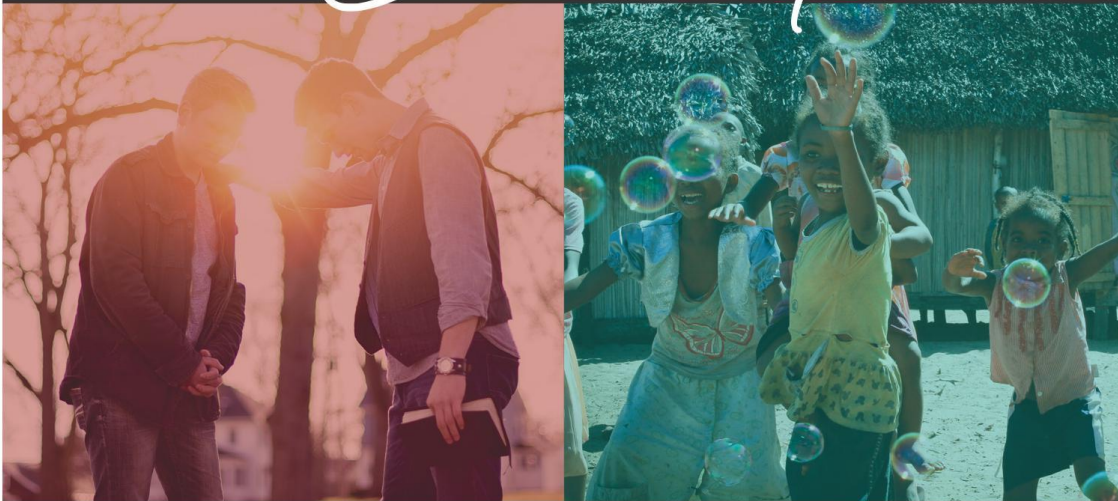
