They will then be delivered to Orphan Grain Train in Wichita, KS. That facility will distribute them to areas in the U.S. or other countries that have experienced a disaster.

If you would like to donate but don't want to shop, envelopes will be available for cash/check donations. (Checks may be made out to BSLC with "for hygiene kits" in the memo line.) ## STEWARDSHIP CORNER

We could say that a contented person sees his cup half-full rather than half-empty. Do your actions indicate that you are content? The Apostle Paul had learned the secret of contentment, for he realized that, in every circumstance, he was in his Father's hands. He had been at the point of death several times. He had suffered much, yet he said, "I have learned to be content whatever the circumstance" (Philippians 4:11). He found that contentment involves learning to love God and to trust in His will regardless of the circumstances in which he found himself. When we abide in Christ through Word and Sacrament, we find contentment. Realizing and recognizing what we have (the presence of God), rather than lamenting what we lack (nothing if we have Christ), brings us contentment.


