


### RED CROSS BLOOD DRIVE




### STEWARSHIP

#### STEWARSHIP CORNER

Jesus spoke to the issue of greed in Matthew 16:26 when He asked, *"For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul? Thus, the deciding factor is the relationship between a person and his wealth. Consider Abraham, one of the richest people in the Bible. 


