SUNDAY SCHOOL

Today, we will study "Consuming Fire." Elijah challenges the people to stop "limping" between Baal and the true God. Gathering the 450 prophets of Baal, Elijah proposes a test to determine the truth: each side will butcher a bull for sacrifice and call on their god to send down fire. The prophets of Baal call upon their god, even cutting themselves to appease it, but nothing happens. Elijah drenches his offering with water, completely filling the trench around it. Then Elijah offers a simple prayer to the true God, who sends down fire from heaven to consume the offering, the wood, and even the water in the trench.

Some important information to note:

- Dangerous snow and ice conditions have already caused the cancellation of hundreds of blood drives in 2025, resulting in several thousand blood and platelet donations going uncollected as the threat of more storms builds.
- Hazardous weather conditions can also make it tougher to move vital blood products across the Red Cross network, potentially affecting deliveries to hospitals in some locations.
- Additionally, cold and flu season may prevent people from keeping donation appointments as they rest and recover from illness.
- The American Red Cross urges donors to give blood or platelets now to help protect the blood supply from the growing impact of severe winter weather. Donors of all blood types – particularly type O negative blood donors and those giving platelets – are needed to help save lives.

There is a cabinet to the right of the check in counter as you face it– just walk in, open and take what you need. You don't need to check in or registrar. Watch the expiration date as it isn't as long as a pharmacy but is free. There are plans to put these cabinets in public libraries soon as well.

FLEECE FABRIC FOR BLANKETS



In February, we will continue to collect fleece fabric to make warm blankets. Your first opportunity to help assemble (tying) the blankets will be at the BSLC Women's Retreat on

Saturday, Feb. 22. It's a very easy process. The blankets will be donated to Orphan Grain Train for distribution to the needy.

- Each blanket uses a **2-yard length** of fleece fabric for the **top** AND a **2-yard length** of fleece fabric for the **bottom**.
- The fabric can be any color. Blankets made in the past have used a fleece design piece for the top with a coordinating solid fleece piece for the bottom.
 - (FYI -These blankets are bigger than the blanket "kits" sold in fabric stores.)
- If you only want to donate a 2-yard piece of fleece, that is fine. We can coordinate it with other donated pieces. We hope to be able to donate several warm blankets.
