and go. Boards offer a way to be part of the BSLC mission.



HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #13 Completed Week of January 27th:

- The electrical contractor finished reinstalling lights in upper-level closets and installed lights and trimmed out the alcove closet.
- The fire suppression contractor completed lowering four (4) sprinkler heads to accommodate the HVAC ductwork in the south Fellowship Hall closet.
- An issue with the drawings and getting approval from the City of Olathe in regard to the east closet revision was addressed and we should have final approval shortly.

Completed Week of February 2nd:

- The electrical contractor finished trimming out the Alcove closet and the Youth Room.
- The roofing/metal contractor finished installing the metal cap/coping on top of the sound wall.
- The concrete contractor finished pouring the sidewalk and patio sections were removed to accommodate the sound enclosure construction.
- The structural contractor installed the sound enclosure door frame and door.
- We received City of Olathe approval on the amended drawings for the east closet addition.

Work Scheduled for week of February 9th:

- The concrete contractor is planning to remove insulated blankets and forms from the sidewalk.
- The City of Olathe is scheduled for above ceiling inspections on the west closets upperlevel and electrical room lower-level and rough in inspections on east closets on Monday.
- We are tentatively scheduled for the structural contractor to return to install ceiling tile and

finish sheetrock, door frames, ceiling grid work in the east closets.

Some important information to note:

- Dangerous snow and ice conditions have already caused the cancellation of hundreds of blood drives in 2025, resulting in several thousand blood and platelet donations going uncollected as the threat of more storms builds.
- Hazardous weather conditions can also make it tougher to move vital blood products across the Red Cross network, potentially affecting deliveries to hospitals in some locations.
- Additionally, cold and flu season may prevent people from keeping donation appointments as they rest and recover from illness.
- The American Red Cross urges donors to give blood or platelets now to help protect the blood supply from the growing impact of severe winter weather. Donors of all blood types – particularly type O negative blood donors and those giving platelets – are needed to help save lives.

There is a cabinet to the right of the check in counter as you face it– just walk in, open and take what you need. You don't need to check in or registrar. Watch the expiration

date as it isn't as long as a pharmacy but is free. There are plans to put these cabinets in public libraries soon as well.
