HYGIENE KITS FOR ORPHAN GRAIN TRAIN

The **TOWEL TOWER** has been set up in the narthex. We are collecting **lightweight, dark-colored, regular-sized bath towels (no oversized) and**

Our goal is 50 kits, but we will assemble as many kits as possible with incoming donations. These kits will be assembled by our Faith Alive group in March or April. They will then be delivered to Orphan Grain Train in Wichita, KS. That facility will distribute them to areas in the U.S. or other countries that have experienced a disaster.

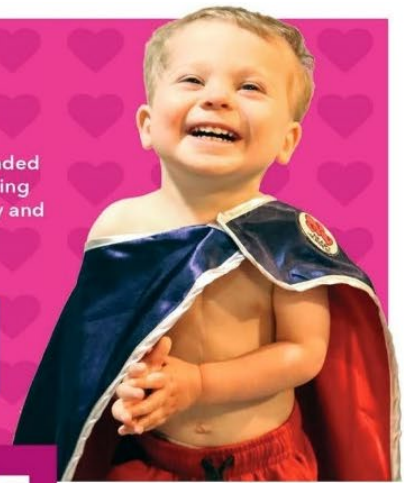
