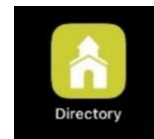


Some important information to note:

- Dangerous snow and ice conditions have already caused the cancellation of hundreds of blood drives in 2025, resulting in several

thousand blood and platelet donations going uncollected as the threat of more storms builds.

- Hazardous weather conditions can also make it tougher to move vital blood products across the Red Cross network, potentially affecting deliveries to hospitals in some locations.
- Additionally, cold and flu season may prevent people from keeping donation appointments as they rest and recover from illness.
- The American Red Cross urges donors to give blood or platelets now to help protect the blood supply from the growing impact of severe winter weather. Donors of all blood types – particularly type O negative blood donors and those giving platelets – are needed to help save lives.
