Realizing the Israelites have no intention of returning, Pharaoh's army pursues the runaways. Caught between Pharaoh's charioteers and the waters of the Red Sea, the

people cry out to God. Moses stretches his hand over the sea as God parts the waters, enabling the people to pass through the sea on dry ground. As Egypt's army attempts to follow, the sea closes in over them, so not one survives. As a family, talk about the ways God protects us from our enemies today.

HYGIENE KITS FOR ORPHAN GRAIN TRAIN -COLLECTION DATE EXTENDED TILL MAR 5



The **TOWEL TOWER** has been set up in the narthex. collecting We are lightweight, darkcolored, regular-sized bath towels (no oversized) and washcloths. Other items

to donate are single-packaged toothbrushes and nail clippers. Some other specific items needed to complete the kits will be purchased with cash/check donations. A Thrivent Action Team will be organized to help with organizing/completing the project.

There has been a very generous supply of toothbrushes given but we are still needing 25 darkcolored, regular-size bath towels with washcloths and **35 nail clippers.** Our goal is 50 kits, but we will assemble as many kits as possible with incoming donations. These kits will be assembled by our Faith Alive group in March or April. They will then be delivered to Orphan Grain Train in Wichita, KS. That facility will distribute them to areas in the U.S. or other countries that have experienced a disaster.

If you would like to donate but don't want to shop, envelopes will be available for cash/check donations. (Checks may be made out to BSLC with "for hygiene kits" in the memo line.) Envelopes can be put in the small, locked, wooden donation box on top of the large wooden box located in the narthex. Questions, contact Charlotte Hundley.
