HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #14

Completed Week of February 10th:

- The structural contractor finished sheet rocking the east closets and installed door frames and ceiling grid.
- The electrical contractor finished installing the lights and switches in the east closets.

- The City of Olathe performed a project inspection. All work for the relocation was approved, but two (2) items from the original Fellowship Hall construction were identified as noncompliant. A PVC vent line was not properly fire protected and the west stairwell was not completely sheet rocked to the roof deck as illustrated in the drawings. We are working to address both of these issues.
- The HVAC contractor was on site to do a control check and help in obtaining sound readings to determine the extent of the amount of sound panels that will need to be installed.

Completed Week of February 17th:

- The painting contractor finished painting the closets and west wall of the Fellowship Hall. This completes all the painting.
- The City of Olathe approved the option of sheet rocking the ceiling in the west stairwell.
- The fire blanket was installed on the PVC sewer vent in the north Fellowship Hall closet. This issue was identified in the last City of Olathe inspection.

Work Scheduled for week of February 24th:

- The flooring contractor to install all base in Fellowship Hall and closets.
- The structural contractor is tentatively scheduled to begin installing sheetrock in the west stairwell.
- HVAC balancing is being pushed out to the first two weeks of March.
- We are planning to complete the measuring on the sound wall so the dimensions can be supplied to the vendors in order that they can provide updated quotes for the sound panels.
