

ARCHITECT SELECTION COMMITTEE – UPDATE PHASE 2 PROJECT – NEW SANCTUARY & PRESCHOOL

In our November 2025 Voters Meeting, we discussed the Phase 2 Project, which is a New Sanctuary and Preschool.

In our January Council Meeting, it was voted to move forward with allocating prior year surplus funds to select and hire an Architect to do 70% design work, and to organize an Architect Selection Committee.
