HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #15

Completed Week of February 24th:

- The structural contractor installed the framing grid and sheetrock in the west stairwell.
 They completed taping and applying the first coat of joint compound of the sheetrock.
- The concrete contractor removed and repoured a section of the patio concrete slab that had elevation issues (low spot).
- The HVAC controls contractor finished final controls adjustment and commissioning.
- The flooring contractor installed the baseboard in the Fellowship Hall closets and youth room.
- Volunteers re-installed the north exit door canopy, sound panels, and fire extinguishers in the Fellowship Hall.
- The City of Olathe confirmed that all required inspections to this point have been approved.

 The dimensional information was sent to the sound panel vendors so that they can provide updated quotes and delivery on the sound panels.

Completed Week of March 3rd:

- The structural contractor finished work on the west stairwell.
- The painters completed painting the west stairwell
- The concrete contractor finished sealing the sidewalk joints and sidewalk.
- The HVAC balancing subcontractor was onsite to determine scope of work.
- We are working with sound panel vendors to finalize quotes for the sound panel. We are looking at a dual-purpose panel for the Fellowship Hall wall that will address the property line sound issue and the sound issue in the lower-level classrooms.

Work Scheduled for week of March 10th:

- The electrical contractor will finish reinstalling lights and motion sensors in the west stairwell.
- The HVAC balancing subcontractor will be on site Tuesday afternoon through Friday to balance the FH HVAC systems.
- If the weather cooperates, the earth work contractor will start the excavating and grading on the north and east side of the Fellowship Hall on Thursday.

When wild lions begin killing these immigrants, the king sends for an Israelite priest, hoping to appease God. 
