Completed Week of March 10th:

- The HVAC contractor completed balancing of the HVAC system.
- The earthwork contractor started grading on the east and north side of the Fellowship Hall.
- The electrical contractor completed work in the west stairwell.

Completed Week of March 17th:

- The earthwork contractor completed excavating and grading on the east and north side of the Fellowship Hall.
- Volunteers completed installing doors on the east closets.
- The irrigation contractor was on site to scope work for next week.
- We continue to evaluate cost quotes on the sound panels.

Work Scheduled for week of March 24th:

- The irrigation contractor will start installing the irrigation on the east and north side of the Fellowship Hall.
- Complete final reviews of panel quotes, select a vendor, and order the sound panels.
- If all the paperwork is in order, we will schedule final inspections for the interior and final mechanical inspections. If we pass them, we will have landscaping and sound inspections remaining to be completed.

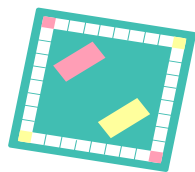
EASTER BREAKFAST PREP
