YOU ARE THE STEWARD OF THE GOOD GIFTS GOD HAS CHOSEN TO GIVE YOU.

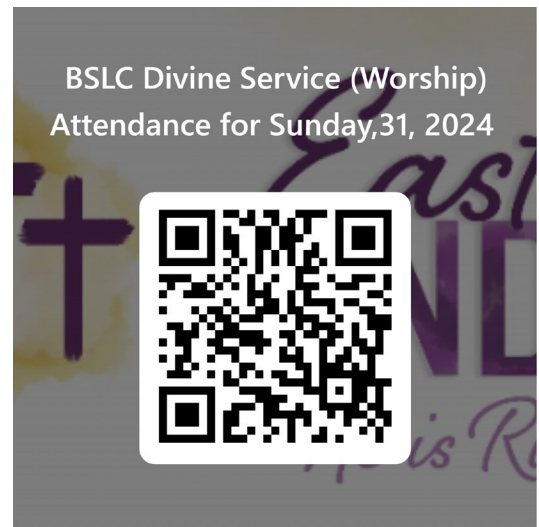
"As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace" (1 Peter 4:10).
