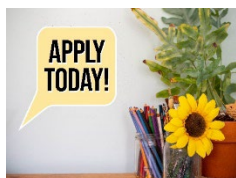

This year we have been supporting **30 students** each week with our donations. Other food items needed are:

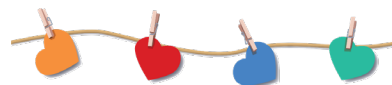
- Fruit cups (preferably fruit cups over applesauce cups)
