### HELP WANTED: USHERS

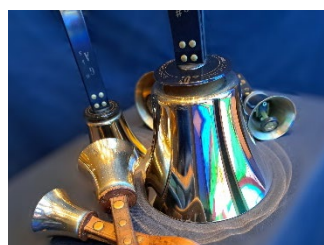


The Ushers play a vital role within our congregation to provide care for people as they enter worship and throughout the worship time. No prior experience is needed just a willing and loving heart to serve.

#### **STEWARDSHIP CORNER**

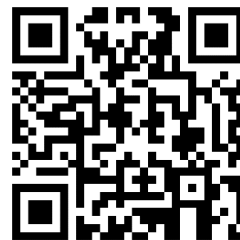
