**LUTHERAN EDUCATION ASSISTANCE ENDOWMENT (LEAF)**

The Lutheran Education Assistance Endowment (LEAF) continues to support families within BSLC who desire a Christ-centered education for their children. All BSLC members already receive a \$1,500 tuition subsidy to attend LCMS K-12 schools in the Kansas City area, but LEAF provides additional, need-based financial assistance to help make enrollment even more accessible.

Established by BSLC members for BSLC families, LEAF exists to ensure that financial barriers don't stand in the way of a Lutheran education. Applications are now open for the 2026-2027 school year, offering support beyond the standard subsidy for qualifying need based families.

**STEWARDSHIP CORNER**

In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus compares the mission field to a vineyard (Matthew 20:1-16). We read, *"For the kingdom of heaven is like a master of a house who went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard"* (verse 1). This is the first verse of a parable known as the "Laborers in the Vineyard." The words and deeds of the employer in this parable point to God. It is God Who freely gives the good gifts and invites us to work. In the parable, the employer hires workers at different times of the day, and, at the end of the day, all workers are paid the same regardless of the hour they were hired. The parable goes against the principle in the world in that the person who works the longest receives the most pay. In the kingdom of God, the principles of merit and ability are set aside so that grace can prevail.
