HVAC CONGREGATION UPDATE #17

Completed Week of March 24th:

- The irrigation contractor completed installation of the irrigation system.
- The sound panel vendor was selected and the process of purchasing the panels was started.

Completed Week of March 31st:

- The project passed final plumbing, electrical, structural, and HVAC inspections by the City of Olathe.
- We received the first set of sound panel layout drawings for 3 of the 4 walls for our review and approval scheduled for Friday, April 4th. Once we review and approve the panel layout, the panels will be put into production, and we are estimating a 4-week lead time.

Work Scheduled for week of April 7th:

- Finish review and approval on the sound panels for the east, west, and north walls and start production on the sound panels.
- The landscaping contractor to install sod and landscaping.

SAVERS FUNDRIE

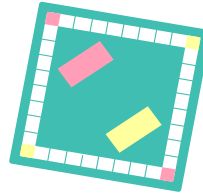
It is time to start bringing your donations for our Savers FunDrive to support the youth! Donations can be dropped off by the signs in the narthex or the



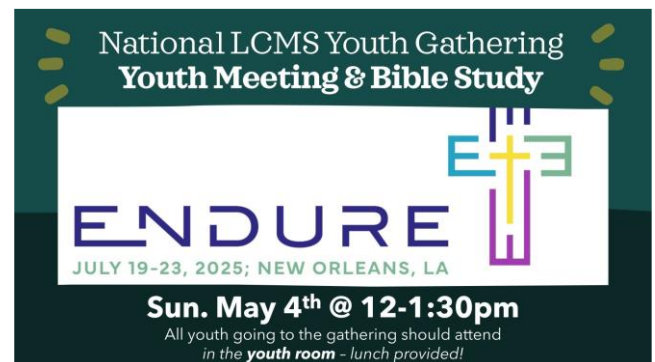
