At the LWML Kansas District convention April 12th-14th, voters selected the mission grants and committed to fund \$48,000 in mission grants and \$40,000 in Student Financial Aid in the next two years. \$5,100 from a Mission Grant Endowment Fund will provide



additional support. Light of the World Lutheran Church & Early Learning Center was selected to be the recipient of an \$8,000 Mission Grant. God's Gracious Gift Fund recipients were also chosen. \$7,464 for those will be paid out in the next few weeks.
