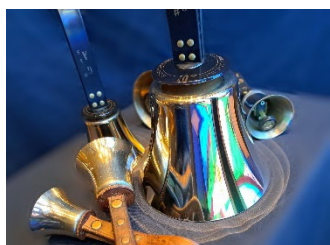

The end of school is approaching. We will make our last delivery of the backsnack items the first

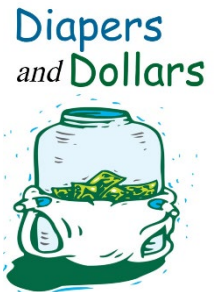
week in May. We could use approximately 30 more of each:

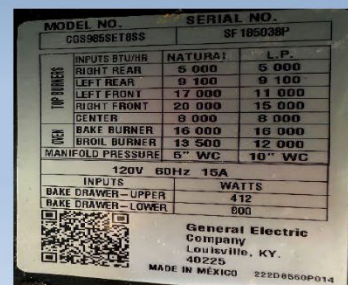
